# Notes

#### IRD number

Show the IRD number that you will be using for all non-resident withholding tax (NRWT) payments for your whole organisation. If you have several branches and would like to account for NRWT separately for each:

- use the IRD number for each individual branch
- use a separate form for each branch (you may photocopy this registration form).

#### Full name

Show the full name of the organisation or payer.

#### Trade name

This is needed if you trade under a different name from your registered name.

## Street address

Show the physical street or location address, not a PO Box number.

#### Postal address

This is the usual mailing address for your business. Don't show your tax agent's address here—if you want your agent to receive your NRWT forms, they will need to let us know separately. We suggest you ask your agent to do this straightaway.

# When will you start paying?

Show the date that you will start paying interest, dividends and/or royalties if you know it (leave it blank if you're unsure). Don't show the date that the first NRWT is due to Inland Revenue.

### Payment dates

How often you have to pay NRWT to Inland Revenue depends on your annual NRWT liability.

# Monthly payments

If you will pay NRWT of \$500 or more each year, you must pay the deductions made in each month by the 20th of the following month.

At Question 11, tick the appropriate months that you will pay interest, dividends and/or royalties. (Note, this is not the month you pay NRWT to Inland Revenue.) We will then send you payment forms for the selected months only.

If you are unsure when you will be paying non-resident withholding income, tick either "every month" or "on request" as appropriate.

If you choose "on request", phone the Non-resident Centre on 03 951 2020 or fax 03 951 2216 whenever you need a payment form. You must return every payment form that you request, even if it's a "nil" payment.

#### Six-monthly payments

If you expect to pay less than \$500 NRWT in any income year, you may pay on a six-monthly basis. We will send you payment forms for the following periods:

- 1 April to 30 September—due for payment on 20 October.
- 1 October to 31 March—due for payment on 20 April.

If your NRWT payment accumulates to more than \$500 during the year, you must send it in by the 20th of the month after it reached \$500. After that you must pay monthly for the rest of that year. If you need to change from paying six-monthly to paying monthly, please contact the Non-resident Centre straightaway.

#### Customised IR 67 certificates

You need to obtain approval to produce your own IR 67 certificates. To get approval, your certificate must contain the information listed in our booklet *Non-resident withholding tax – payer's guide (IR 291)*. To apply, send a copy of your proposed certificate to the Non-resident Centre, Inland Revenue, Private Bag 1932, Dunedin 9054.

### Filing IR 67 certificates

When you file your end-of-year reconciliation, you may send us your certificates on a disk (including 3.5" floppy, CD or DVD). Specifications are available on the Software Developer's page on our website or by contacting the Magmedia Team at:
